

- I. Ethics in Psychiatric Practice Core Curriculum Pre and Post-Course Quiz: Residents will complete a quiz to test their incoming knowledge before they begin the curriculum. The answers to this initial pre-course quiz will not be shared with the residents. During the wrap-up session of the course, the residents will again take the quiz they completed the first session, having now finished the course and gained knowledge taught in the course about ethics in psychiatry. During this final session, the facilitator / faculty member conducting this session will review the correct answers to the quiz with the residents and pass back the initial quizzes so the residents can reflect personally on the progress they have made in mastering the material they have learned in the course.
- II. In-Module Assessment: The “Ethics Terminology” quiz for Module One and the discussion questions within each module allow for continuous assessment throughout the curriculum.
- III. Resident Curriculum Evaluation: Residents will each complete a personal anonymous evaluation, rating their perceived quality of the Ethics in Psychiatric Practice Core Curriculum material and of the faculty / facilitators of the course.
- IV. Knowledge Outcomes: The Pre- and Post-Course quiz reviews will offer insight into assessing the mastery of the knowledge taught in the curriculum as compared to the knowledge that the residents entered the course with.
- V. Observable Behavior Changes: Residents will be better equipped to handle ethical dilemmas that arise in practice.
